Insurance Company has offered an amount of Rs.3,75,000/- over and above the amount of compensation already awarded by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal towards full and final claim of the appellants. Offer given by the Insurance Company is acceptable to the appellants.

Learned counsel for the appellants submits that appeal be disposed of in terms of offer of enhancement given by the Insurance Company.

Accordingly, in the light of understanding between the parties, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.3,75,000/- in the name of the appellants with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of four weeks, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on the enhanced amount of compensation with effect from the due date till final realisation of the amount. The apportionment of the

enhanced amount shall be made in the same manner as observed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal. On receiving the cheque from the Insurance Company, the concerned officer/official of the Lok Adalat Branch shall issue proper receipt to the Insurance Company. The appellant/appellant's counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of this order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
