The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned action of respondent-authority, in not revising the pension of the petitioner in view of the Revised Pay Rules, 2016 and further for not granting the revised amount of Fixed Medical Allowance and LTC for the last span of three years, as the other similar employee has already been granted the same benefit in compliance of order dated 22.01.2020 (Annexure P-4).

At the outset, the counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if respondents are directed to decide the legal notice dated 28.09.2021 (Annexure P-5), within some time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and has submitted that the State is not averse to expeditious disposal of grievance of the petitioner.

In view of the above, respondents-State is directed to take a conscious decision upon legal notice dated 28.09.2021 (Annexure P-5), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that in case the petitioner is found entitled to the financial benefits on such conscious decision to be taken by the respondents-State, then the same shall be actually released to the petitioner within a further period of three months from the date of such decision.

The petition stands disposed of with above said direction.
