The matter is taken up through the medium of video conferencing.

The consent form has been received from the office of Mr. Ashit Malik, Advocate dated 10.12.2021 whereby both the parties have agreed for full and final settlement with the enhanced compensation of Rs.4,50,000/- (Rs. Four Lakh and Fifty Thousand only) over and above the main award passed by the learned Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri, i.e. Rs.4,58,000/-.

The appellants shall be required to provide their bank account details to the Insurance Company within a period of two weeks from today for the purpose of transferring the aforesaid enhanced amount by way of RTGS.

Insurance Company undertakes to release the payment of enhanced compensation within a period of four weeks from today through RTGS in the respective accounts of the appellants-claimants as per their share, failing which, the enhanced amount of compensation, as stated herein above, shall carry interest @ 9% per annum from the date it becomes due till the date of its actual realization.

Further, in case the appellants fail to provide the details of their bank accounts to the Insurance Company, the Insurance Company will be at

liberty to issue Demand Drafts against the said amount in favour of the appellants.

Appeal stands disposed of accordingly.

Copy of this order be supplied to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
