This is the second petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.235 dated 05.06.2019, registered for offences under Sections 306 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Safidon, District Jind (Annexure P-1).

When confronted with the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***G.R.Ananda Babu Vs. The State of Tamil Nadu and others 2021 SCC Online SC 176***, regarding the maintainability of second petition, counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the petition, however, he submits that petitioner will surrender before the Trial Court within a period of two weeks from today and move a petition for regular bail, which may be ordered to be heard in a time bound manner.

Request of the counsel has been considered.

Let petitioner shall surrender before the Trial Court within a period of two weeks from today. In case, he does so and files an application seeking grant of regular bail, the Trial Court shall make an endeavour and decide it within a period of one week from the date of its filing.

Petition is disposed of.
