Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.304 dated 05.09.2019, under Sections 147, 148, 323, 452, 506 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station Bhondsi, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is outcome of a matrimonial dispute which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised. He has referred to the copy of the settlement dated 12.12.2019 arrived at in the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

This Court, by the order dated 03.10.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioners have joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 03.10.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
