Learned State counsel has informed that the trial is at the fag end and the next date of hearing before the trial court fixed is 18.02.2021. While delivering the judgment, the trial court is required to make order with regard to disposal of the vehicle in which contraband was being carried, in accordance with law. In that way, release of vehicle on sapurdari during the pendency of the trial will not serve any purpose.

Therefore, the petition is disposed of with the observation that the petitioner may take recourse to another legal remedy available to him, if he feels aggrieved by any order passed by the trial court with regard to disposal of the vehicle in question.
