The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *certiorari* for quashing the action of the respondents whereby the respondents are proceeding to deduct the additional 5 marks awarded to the petitioner under Socio Economic Criteria and further, to disqualify the petitioner despite the fact that the petitioner has already been declared selected on the post of Sub-Inspector (Male) as per Final Result dated 31.10.2021 (Annexure P-8) as he obtained 71.60 marks whereas the cut-off is 66.60 marks in the category of petitioner, as the same being illegal, arbitrary,

discriminatory, against the principles of natural justice and equity.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

Mr. Gaurav Jindal, Addl.A.G., Haryana puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. Copy supplied.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel of both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the representations dated 30.11.2021 (Annexures P-18 and P-19) moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the relief, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
