This is a petition filed on behalf of the petitioner for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.30, dated 03.02.2021, under Sections 394/34/411 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Siwan, District Kaithal.

2. The petitioner has remained in detention in the present case for more than ten months, since 07.02.2021. He was originally not named in the FIR. Challan against him has already been submitted, after completion of the investigation. Charges have been framed and one prosecution witness out of the total ten prosecution witnesses has so far been examined. The trial is likely to take some time to conclude. There is also no record of the petitioner's involvement in any other criminal case.

3. In view of the above, without commenting any further on merits of the present case as a whole and considering the detention

undergone by the petitioner so far, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose would be served by keeping him in detention for an indefinite period of time. Therefore, his prayer for regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail, subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
