Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the present petition has been filed for impartial and unbiased investigation in FIR No.0175, dated 19.10.2021, registered under Sections 452, 323, 427, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Sadar, District Ferozepur, Punjab, and further prayer of the petitioners is that keeping in view the registration of the above-said FIR on the asking of the petitioners, the private respondents, who are the accused, are putting pressure on the petitioners to withdraw the same and keeping in view certain developments, the petitioners apprehend threat to their life and liberty as well. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the said grievance, has already been raised by the petitioners, before respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur by filing representation dated 03.12.2021 (Annexure P-2), which is still pending

consideration and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Learned State counsel raises no objection for decision of the representation dated 03.12.2021 (Annexure P-2) by respondent No.2 in a time bound manner.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in representation dated 03.12.2021, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the representation dated 03.12.2021 (Annexure P-2) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
