By this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.75, dated 04.07.2019, registered at Police Station Women, Jind, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 498-A, 323, 506, 406 and 34 of the IPC (with Section 377 IPC deleted after completion of investigation), as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the matter has been compromised between the petitioner and respondent no.2, i.e. the complainant in the FIR, the petitioner no longer wishes to press this petition and in fact would now be filing a petition seeking quashing of the FIR in question on the basis of the compromise reached between the parties.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with obviously liberty available to file such a petition.
