The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.56 dated 18.04.2019 under Sections 420/406 IPC, registered at Police Station City Batala, District Gurdaspur.

The operative part of the order dated 30.09.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.56 dated 18.04.2019 under Sections 420/406 IPC, registered at Police Station City Batala, District Gurdaspur.

List again on 23.10.2019.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer within a period of 10 days to join investigation and he shall be released on interim bail on furnishing bail/surety bonds subject to the following conditions:-

CASE HEARD THROUGH VIDEO CONFERENCING

1. He shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;

2. He shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer; and

3. He shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court...”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 30.09.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Baljeet Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 30.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
