HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is already a civil dispute going on between the parties but despite there being an order passed by this Court in one of the proceedings, the same is being violated by the other side, which is headed by respondent No.5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner gave a complaint to respondent No.3 with regard to the violation of the order passed by this Court against respondent No.5 and when the police officials went to enquire about the said complaint, respondent No.5 alongwith the other people gathered outside his house and abused the petitioner and also threatened him with dire consequences and directed him to withdraw the said complaint due to which the petitioner has apprehension with regard to the threat to his life and liberty.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already given a representation dated 03.12.2021 (Annexure P-14) to respondent No.3 and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the said authority to decide the representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State raises no objection for deciding the representation dated 03.12.2021 (Annexure P-14) of the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 03.12.2021 (Annexure P-14), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 03.12.2021 (Annexure P-14) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
