Petitioner herein, *inter alia*, seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant/ provide additional/ last opportunity for scrutiny of documents for the post of Mechanic Electronics Instructor (Theory) (Cat. No.28 in Adv. No12/2019) in the Department of Skill Development and Industrial Training.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that result of the written examination for the post of Mechanic Electronics Instructor (Theory) was declared on 19.09.2021 and the petitioner was shortlisted for the said post. He submits that the petitioner, due to family reasons, could not visit the website regularly and came to know of the result for the first time only on 28.11.2021. Thereafter, he immediately moved a representation dated 29.11.2021 (Annexure P-4) before the respondent-Haryana Staff Selection Commission for granting him an opportunity for scrutiny of documents.

3. Learned State counsel, on advance service, appears and states that competent authority shall take appropriate decision on the pending representation dated 29.11.2021 (Annexure P-4).

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner also agrees that let a final decision be taken, either way, by the competent authority on the pending representation dated 29.11.2021 (Annexure P-4).

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioner as per representation dated 29.11.2021 (Annexure P-4) and also by keeping in view the contention raised in the present petition by treating the same as supplementary representation and take a decision, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of 30 days from today.

8. Disposed of accordingly.
