The petitioner has filed the present petition for issuance of directions to the official respondents to conduct fair and unbiased investigation in FIR No.250 dated 30.09.2021 under Sections 498-A, 354-A, 323, 406, 506 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station City Nuh, District Nuh and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members from danger at the hands of respondents No.5 to 7.

Learned State counsel has apprised the Court that the instant petition has been rendered infructuous as two of the accused, namely Shabbir and Asar Khan, already stand arrested.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.7 has been extending threats of dire consequences to her.

On a query put to the learned counsel for the petitioner as to what threats had been extended by respondent No.7, she merely submitted that the threats were of various kinds. Still further on a

pointed query, whether some complaint had been made to the authorities concerned qua the alleged subsequent threats, she replied in the negative.

In the light of the submissions made by the learned State counsel, the instant petition is rendered infructuous and is dismissed as such. However, in case of any grievance, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail of alternative remedies under the provisions of law.
