ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

Apprehending danger to their lives at the hands' of private respondents No.4 to 6, the petitioner No.1 (adult) whereas petitioner No.2 who is stated to be 17 years and 10 months, have come up before this Court seeking protection of their lives.

Learned State counsel submits that presently petitioner NO.2 is in Child Welfare Committee, Sirsa and as per instructions she is willing to go with her parents at her own free will. He further submits that there is no threat perception to the petitioners

Parents of petitioner No.2 (Rajni Kaur) (respondents No.4 and 5) are present in Court. They have stated that they want the custody of petitioner No.2 from Child Welfare committee, Sirsa and assures this Court that they would not marry her until she attains the age of majority and further they would not marry her against her wishes, rather they would

marry her as per her choice. They would not give any beating, threat or any harm to her.

Given above, learned State counsel is requested to convey to the Incharge concerned of the Child Welfare Committee to hand over the custody of the petitioner No.2 (Rajni Kaur) to her parents today itself.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of with liberty to petitioner No.1 to approach this Court, in case threat perception arises in future. It is clarified that since there is no adjudication on merits, as such the contents of petition shall not be read in evidence.

Interim order dated 16.12.2021 is hereby recalled.
