ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 252 dated 21.10.2021, under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is the mother of the girl, who was married to the son of the complainant. It is alleged that the daughter of the petitioner, who had been sent abroad at the expense of the complainant, did not take the son of the complainant with her. He, however, contends that the daughter of the petitioner had made every effort to take her husband abroad, but due to discrepancy in the papers, he could not go abroad. He also contends that even now the daughter of the petitioner is willing to make earnest endeavour to take the son of the complainant abroad.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that in view of the serious allegations against the petitioner, she is not entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail.

This Court, by the order dated 15.12.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel contends that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 15.12.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
