Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for directing the respondents to release balance amount of dues pending on account of contractual services rendered by the petitioners as Account Assistants (Part Time).

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioners, states that at this stage, instead of pressing the petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied, in case, legal notice dated 17.12.2020 (P-4) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.5-The Executive Engineer, Water Supply and Sanitation Division, Malout, Distt. Sri Muktsar Sahib, to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 17.12.2020 (P-4), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
