Due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, the instant case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *certiorari* for partly quashing the impugned order dated 06.11.2013 (Annexure P-2) vide which the petitioner is appointed as Superintendent Grade-II but not granted the benefit of higher scale of Superintendent Grade-II and other financial benefits attached with the posts as per Government Letter Instructions dated 17.07.2002 (Annexure P-8) and law laid down by the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court in CWP-10495-2016 (Annexure P-6).

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the representation dated 06.10.2015 (Annexure P-3) and legal notice dated 06.02.2022 (Annexure P-4) as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the relief, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

Since, no one is present on behalf of the State of Punjab, the learned Advocate General, Punjab be notified of this order for compliance.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
