The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of order dated 02.11.2019 (Annexure P-1) passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hoshiarpur in case bearing No. COMA-106 of 2017 whereby the petitioners have been declared as proclaimed persons and for staying the operation of the said impugned order during the pendency of the present petition.

It is submitted that the petitioners were issued summons to face trial in complaint case bearing No.COMA-106 of 2017, failing which non-bailable warrants were issued against them and vide impugned order dated 02.11.2019, the petitioners have been declared as proclaimed persons.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are ready to surrender before learned trial Court and file application for regular bail.

notice on behalf of the respondent State.

The ends of justice will be fully met if the petitioners are permitted to surrender before before learned trial Court and move fresh application for grant of regular bail.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the petitioners to surrender before learned trial Court on 10.01.2022 and move fresh application for grant of regular bail, which will be decided by the trial Court preferably on the very same day.

It is further directed that till then, the order dated 02.11.2019 declaring the petitioners as proclaimed persons, shall be kept in abeyance.
