Due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, the instant case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226 of the Constitution of India with *inter alia* humble prayer for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction to the respondents to release benefits of pension and gratuity to the petitioner along with the 18% interest from the date of accrual till date of payment.

Upon hearing learned counsel of both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off

with the directions to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 21.10.2021 (Annexure P-2) as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the relief, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

Since, no one is present on behalf of the State of Punjab, the learned Advocate General, Punjab be notified of this order for compliance.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
