AJAY TEWARI, J (ORAL)

By this petition, the petitioner has claimed that while filling up the form for HCS (Judicial Branch), Examination 2020-21, he inadvertently wrongly ticked on the box of Category 'General-Unreserved' rather than 'Scheduled Castes for Haryana'.

2. The prayer now is that the petitioner be considered as a scheduled caste candidate and declare result as scheduled caste candidate since he actually belongs to the scheduled caste.

3. We are afraid that it could not be possible for this Court to exercise writ jurisdiction to come to the assistance of the petitioner. The larger issue involved is whether if such kind of petitions are allowed to be made, then the selection process can never be over.

4. It bears mention here that the petitioner by his own showing moved a representation only when he got the admit card in which he was reflected as an unreserved candidate.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the judgment of the Division Bench of this Court in **LPA-320-2019**, titled as **“Haryana Staff Selection Commission through its Secretary vs. Sarla and others”** decided on 22.02.2019 to contend that in that case a human error was made in the application. However, in that case the applicant was a poor village lady, resident of village Karora, District Kaithal, where she was working as an Anganwari Worker and it was found that online application form was submitted by her through computer centre in the village. The present is a case of an aspirant to the class I post of HCS (Judicial Branch). The facts are completely distinguishable.

6. Therefore, the petition stands dismissed in limine.

7. Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
