HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that though, there is a matrimonial dispute between the petitioner and respondent No.5 but, respondent No.4 is helping respondent No.5 in a manner, which is not in accordance with law. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is being made grant to appear before the police authorities time and again in connection with the complaints which are being preferred by respondent No.5 so as to harass the petitioner. Learned counsel further argues that the grievance which has been raised by the petitioner in the present petition, has already been brought to the notice of respondent No.2 by representation dated 01.12.2021 (Anneuxre P-4) a copy of which is also sent to respondent No.3 which is still pending consideration before the aforesaid authorities and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3-State.

Learned State counsel raises no objection for decision of the representation dated 01.12.2021 (Annexure P-4) by respondent No.3 by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, respondent No.3 is directed to decide the representation dated 01.12.2021 (Annexure P/4) submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. It shall be appreciated that all the parties, who are likely to be affected by the outcome of the said order, are heard before passing of the order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
