The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.185 dated 21.06.2019 under Sections 323, 406 & 498-A of IPC registered at Police Station Model Town, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that the matter has in fact been compromised between the parties and a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act has also been filed.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rashpal Singh, also confirms the facts as stated by the counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the fact that a compromise has been effected between the parties, custodial interrogation of the petitioner would not be required.

The petition is accordingly allowed. The petitioner is allowed to join the investigation as and when required and in the event of arrest shall be released on bail to the satisfactory of the Arresting Officer subject to the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
