At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition, while submitting that the petitioner would be surrendering before the Court below tomorrow, i.e 21.12.2021, and would be moving an application for seeking the relief of regular bail there and he further prays that the concerned Court be directed to decide the said bail application within some specific time frame.

Mr. Amitoj Singh Dhaliwal, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings in this case in pursuance of the copy of the instant petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance, has no objection to the above-discussed submission as well as

the prayer as made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn.

However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court/concerned Court below on the afore-said date and moves any application for seeking regular bail, then the same shall be decided within three days, in accordance with law, in view of the facts and circumstances of the case.
