Mr.Anurag Chopra, counsel for the applicant/petitioner submits that in the light of certain subsequent developments he has instructions not to pursue the main writ petition.

Main case

Challenge in the instant petition was to a notification dated 13.09.2019 (Annexure P-6) whereby area of village Manakpur Kalar had been declared as an industrial zone.

Mr.Anurag Chopra, counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of a subsequent notification dated 15.01.2020 (appended as Annexure A-1 along with CM-16675-CWP-2021), the grievance of the petitioner does not survive as of now.

He further submits that he has instructions from the petitioner not to pursue the instant writ petition.

Writ petition is disposed of as not pressed.
