Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to take appropriate action as per law against private respondents No.5 to 8 for demanding dowry, harassing and ruining the life of the petitioner and misappropriating the *Istridhan* by considering the representation dated 06.09.2021, Annexure P-4.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the marriage of the petitioner was solemnized with Manjinder Singh, respondent No.5, on 14.10.2016 and two children were born out of the wedlock. Counsel submits that various items were given by way of dowry and gift's to her husband as well as her in-laws, however, they were not satisfied with the same and have been repeatedly physically assaulting and harassing the

petitioner and tried to strangle her. He submits that on 08.07.2021, she was assaulted by the private respondents and was admitted in the Civil Hospital, Malerkotla. He has referred to the MLR, Annexure P-1, to submit that she suffered three injuries. He submits that despite the fact that the statement of the petitioner was recorded and a representation, Annexure P-4, was submitted and marked to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkotla, but no action has been taken. Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if in case a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into the said representation.

Request of counsel has been considered.

Without examining the allegations levelled in the petition or in the representation, petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkotla, District Malerkotla, to examine the representation, Annexure P-4, and take suitable action thereon as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of the order along with the representation, Annexure P-4, be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkotla, District Malerkotla to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
