The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by the petitioner, seeking concession of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.106 dated 28.08.2019, under Sections 406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Nurbur Bedi, District Rupnagar, Punjab.

2. It is submitted by Ld. State Counsel that in the interregnum, investigation has already been completed and Challan filed in the Ld. Trial Court on 04.12.2020.

3. Consequently, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is certainly not called for at this stage, since the matter has now reached the stage of trial.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail earlier granted to the petitioner in the case is, therefore, ordered to be confirmed.
