The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* seeking directions to the respondents to rectify the date of notional promotion of the petitioner to a date when he become eligible on passing of matriculation examination with all consequential service benefits and stepping up his pay equal to his juniors, for which, a legal notice dated 20.08.2019 (Annexure P-15) has also been served upon the respondent-authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the

directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the legal notice dated 20.08.2019 (Annexure P-15) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay.
