HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed seeking direction to respondent No.3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, which according to the petitioner, is under threat at the hands of respondents No. 5 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, who is an NRI, is involved in property dispute with the private respondents and though, the civil proceedings are pending, the petitioner is being threatened and is not being allowed to enjoy his property. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has been threatened not to enter his property, hence, the prayer of the petitioner is for protecting his life and liberty, which is under threat, at the hands of the private

respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the Director General of Police (Punjab), Sector-9, Chandigarh vide representation dated 08.12.2021 (Annexure P-2), which is still pending consideration with the said authority and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State raises no objection in decision of the representation of the petitioner by respondent No.2 in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 08.12.2021 (Annexure P-2), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 08.12.2021(Annexure P-2) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
