1. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner's date of birth is 06.04.1968 as is evident from the Aadhaar Card and Pan Card Annexures P-2 and P-3, besides Identity Card Annexure P-1 issued by respondent No.3, yet the respondents are proposing to retire the petitioner w.e.f. 31.01.2022 purportedly on account of his attaining the age of superannuation i.e. 58 years on said date. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner has submitted representation Annexure P-5 as well as legal notice Annexure P-12 for supply of copy of Enrollment Form, Central Rolls as well as fresh Identity Card but to no avail, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P/5 dated 17.10.2021 and legal notice Annexure P-12 dated 01.11.2021, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

2. Notice of motion to respondent No.3 only.

3. Mr. Ayush Sarna, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.3 and on perusal of the writ petition states that he has no

objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel for the parties, gone over the paper-book and in view of the nature of order proposed to be passed, there is no necessity to seek reply in the matter.

5. Accordingly, in the light of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the writ petition is *disposed of* by directing respondent No. 3 to consider and decide the claim made in representation Annexure P/5 dated 17.10.2021 and legal notice Annexure P-12 dated 01.11.2021, in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter within two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and furnish copy of the decision to the petitioner.
