HARINDER SINGH SIDHU J.

The petitioner has filed the present contempt petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act for deliberate, willful and intentional disobedience of the order dated 07.9.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.12087 of 2016 and order dated 11.2.2020 passed in LPA No.1843 of 2018.

Mr. Chatrath, learned counsel for the respondents states that before the amount can be transferred, two separate bank accounts in the names of minor children, through their natural guardian, are required to be opened. The petitioner is also required to furnish an undertaking before the respondents that the amount transferred into the accounts of the minor children would be converted into fixed deposits, which would not be encashed till the children attained the age of majority.

Learned counsel for the respondents further states that once the aforesaid is done, the amount would be transferred to the accounts of the minor children within ten days. He also undertakes that the amount falling to the share of the petitioner would be transferred into her bank account within two weeks.

In view of the aforesaid, the petition is disposed of.
