The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to count the work charge service period of the petitioner along with his regular service for the purpose of grant of pensionary benefits in terms of judgments of this Court (Annexures P2 to P4) and instructions of the Punjab Govt. (Annexure P1) with a further direction to pay him the entire arrears along with interest @ 18% p.a. as well as to decide the representation dated 04.09.2021 (Annexure P-6).

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider the representation of the

petitioner dated 04.09.2021 (Annexure P6), and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
