1. Prayer in the petition under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/2 dated 27.10.2021, in CWP-21709-2021.

2. Learned counsel contends that vide order Annexure P/2 dated 27.10.2021, CWP-21709-2021 was disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to pursue representation dated 05.10.2021 and the respondent was directed to consider and decide the same in accordance with law. Learned counsel contends that pursuant to the filing of the contempt petition, the respondent decided the representation vide order dated 12.12.2021 and the said decision was challenged by the petitioner by filing civil writ petition which was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 16.12.2021, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

3. In view of the position noted above, and compliance with the order of this Court Annexure P/2 dated 27.10.2021, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is called for against the respondent. The contempt petition is disposed of accordingly.
