Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 263 dated 19.11.2021 registered under Sections 379, 411, 201 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Nagina, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no proof regarding the involvement of the petitioner in the purchase of stolen vehicles and he is not the owner of the godown from where the recovery of alleged stolen vehicles was effected.

It is a case, wherein ASI Rajbir had conducted a raid on the godown on the secret information, from where two stolen vehicles were recovered. When the owners of the said vehicles were traced, they identified

the said two vehicles as stolen ones.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he purchases the stolen vehicles and after dismantling the same, sells their parts in the open market. Such allegations are very serious and, therefore, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is must to unearth the gang of carjackers. Hence, no ground to grant him the concession of anticipatory bail is made out.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
