Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to remove the anomaly between the pay of senior and junior Government employees occurred due to implementation in view of notification dated 22.08.2019 (P-8).

Learned counsel for the petitioners, on instructions, submits that at this stage, instead of pressing the writ petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case, legal notice dated 07.10.2021 (P-9) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2- The Director Public Instructions (SE), Punjab, Punjab School Education Board, Mohali, to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 07.10.2021 (P-9), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
