The petitioner alleges that allotment of ration depot has been made to respondent No.4 in an illegal manner and only because he is the husband of the Sarpanch of the village. No public notice was issued inviting applications from the public at large for the said depot and thus, the allotment to respondent No.4 is illegal.

In support of the averment that no public notice was issued, affidavits of the Panches of the village have been filed. However, before filing the writ petition, no representation has been made to the concerned authorities. Thus, the writ petition cannot be entertained at this stage.

Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw this petition at this stage to make an appropriate representation to the concerned authorities.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
