JASGURPREET SINGH PURI. J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for directing the official respondents No.1 to 3 to grant protection of the life and liberty of the petitioner.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the scope of the present petition is confined only for the protection of life of the petitioner and he does not wish to agitate or to press anything *inter se* relationship between the petitioner and the private respondents. He submitted that the petitioner was married to respondent No.6 who was already married and had concealed his marriage from her and thereafter physical as well as mental harassment has been caused to the petitioner and, therefore, she has filed a representation before the Superintendent of Police, District Gurugram, vide Annexure P-2 dated 13.12.2021 and has further stated that the private respondents have filed a complaint before the Police Station Sadar, Palwal that the petitioner has gone missing and under the pretext of the same, the police is now raiding

the house of the petitioner. He has submitted that at this stage, he will be satisfied in case the representation given by the petitioner to the Superintendent of Police, District Gurugram be taken into consideration in accordance with law.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 5 only.

Mr. Naveen Singh Panwar, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the aforesaid respondents and has stated that he has no objection in case appropriate direction is issued to the Commissioner of Police, District Gurugram to consider the complaint/representation Annexure P-2 filed by the petitioner in accordance with law and if so required then appropriate action may be taken in accordance with law.

I have heard the learned counsels for the parties.

This Court is satisfied that the present petition can be disposed of even without calling the reply from the respondents in view of the fact that the present petition can be disposed of by issuance of directions to the Commissioner of Police, Gurugram to consider the representation filed by the petitioner.

It is, therefore, directed that the Commissioner of Police Gurugram shall consider the representation Annexure P-2 filed by the petitioner in accordance with law and if it is so required then to take further appropriate action in accordance with law.

Disposed of accordingly.
