Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the petitioners, who are senior citizens, are being harassed by private respondents No. 4 and 5 as there is a dispute between them qua property. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the grievance as raised in the present petition has already been brought to the notice of respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) vide representation dated 20.11.2021 (Annexure P-1), which is still pending consideration with the said authority and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the said representation dated 20.11.2021 (Annexure P-1) in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 20.11.2021 (Annexure P-1) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the representation dated 20.11.2021 (Annexure P-1) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

It will be appreciated that all the persons, who are likely to be affected by the outcome of the said representation, are heard before passing the speaking order.

Present petition stands disposed of.
