Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to take action against respondent No.6, who has forged a false sale deed bearing vasika No.2554 dated 11.08.1975 and on the basis of same sale deed, he has got sanctioned the mutation.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that the parties are closely related and proceedings relating to the mutation (Annexure P-1 and P-2) are pending before the Sub Divisional Magistrate-cum-Assistant Collector, Ist Grade-Abohar. The mere grievance that representations dated 19.05.2021 and 02.11.2021 (Annexures P-3 and P-5, respectively) regarding registration of FIR is not being looked into by the senior police officers is not enough for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C at this stage, as the petitioner can avail alternative remedy.

Resultantly, petition is dismissed.
