The petitioners have filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to implement and carry out the mandate of the Statutory Rules and consider the petitioners for promotion for the post of Superintendence Grade II, in the existing vacancy of BBMB share quota w.e.f. 05/06.07.2019; along with certain other prayers.

At the outset, the counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage the petitioners would be satisfied if respondents are directed to decide the representations (Annexures P-7 to 10), within some time bound frame.

Mr. Pritish Goel, Advocate, appearing for Mr. Amar Vivek Aggarwal, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-BBMB and has submitted that the respondents are not averse to expeditious disposal of grievance of the petitioners.
