Petitioner has preferred this writ petition for the issuance of an appropriate order in the nature of mandamus, directing the officials of respondent Nos.2 to 4 to provide adequate protection to the petitioner from private respondent Nos.5 to 8, who are President and Members of the Truck Union, Doraha, District Ludhiana, as the private respondents are not allowing loading of foodgrains in the vehicles provided by the petitioner, who is a Government/FCI Contractor. Private respondents have posed a real threat of causing financial loss to the State exchequer and also intend to disrupt the tender work of the petitioner so as to cause material damage to him.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case his representation dated 09.12.2021 submitted before respondent No.3 is ordered to be decided in accordance with law within a specified period.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court Mr. T.P.S. Chawla, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab.

In view of nature of order which this Court purposes to pass there would be no requirement to obtain a response from the State or private respondents at this stage.

This petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider the pending representation of the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
