The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing
on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

As per the statements of the learned counsel for the parties,
respectively, made before this Bench, it has been agreed that a sum of
Rs.35,000/- (Rupees Thirty five thousand only) over and above the
amount awarded by the Tribunal shall be paid to the appellants in full and
final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned
counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.2-
Harmail Singh, subject to no objection from the remaining appellants,
within a period of two months.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the
Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.35,000/- in the

name of appellant No.2-Harmail Singh, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order.

The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent – Insurance Company. The appellants' counsel/appellant no.2 may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

A copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
