The instant criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate writ, order or directions to official respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from any untoward incident at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, would submit that for his grievance, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 21.10.2021 (Annexure P-2) to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana i.e. respondent No.2 herein, but no action has been taken thereon so far. The petitioner would be satisfied in case the said representation be decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rashmi Attri, AAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents

and would submit that the official respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to take a decision on the representation dated 21.10.2021 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
