This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to decide the service claims of the petitioners, as claimed in para No. 19 of the legal notice dated 1.10.2021 (Annexure P-10) expeditiously in a time bound manner and before his retirement.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents – Indian Oil Corporation and filed his memo of appearance, which is taken on record. Even counsel for the respondents is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2; to decide the legal notice issued by the petitioner dated 1.10.2021 (Annexure P-10) and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order; within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that if the petitioner is found entitled to any pecuniary benefits upon such a conscious decision; then the said pecuniary benefits shall also be released to the petitioner within a further period of 3 months; from the date of such conscious decision of the authorities.
