The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to count the work-charge/adhoc service with effect from 01.02.1975 to 09.12.1981 followed by regular service towards pensionary benefits including pension, gratuity, GP Fund and leave encashment etc. and to release him the aforesaid revised pensionary benefits after counting his work-charge/adhoc service along with interest @ 12% p.a. as well as to decide the legal notice dated 15.10.2021 (Annexure P-3).

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated

15.10.2021 (Annexure P3) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
