HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 327 dated 29.08.2017, registered under Sections 302, 201 read with 34 IPC, and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Rajendra Park, District Gurugram, the first having been dismissed as withdrawn.

At the outset, learned State counsel points out that all the prosecution witnesses have been examined and the case is at the fag end. Besides, it is pointed out that the petitioner is an accused of a serious crime and therefore, keeping in view the gravity of the offence, he is not entitled to the concession of regular bail.

As noticed above, all the prosecution witnesses stand examined, which indicates that the trial is going at a proper pace. Moreover, the petitioner is accused of serious offence under Section 302 IPC. Therefore, this Court does not find any ground to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail.

Dismissed.
