The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 25.11.2020 (Annexure P5) passed by respondent No.2 with regard to grant of B.Ed. Grade with a further prayer to the respondents to refix and pay retiral dues with arrears to the petitioner as well as to decide the representation dated 05.03.2021 (Annexure P-6).

Ms. Simran Grewal, Asst. Advocate General, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to her.

Upon hearing learned counsel for both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents, especially respondent No.2, to consider the representation dated 05.03.2021 (Annexure P6) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
