Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.27 dated 22.08.2019, under Sections 406, 498-A of the IPC, registered at Police Station Women, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the parties have already got the divorce under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act by virtue of decree dated 25.10.2021.

By virtue of the order dated 15.07.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions has endorsed the same and

submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the same, the interim order dated 15.07.2021, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
