Present contempt petition has been filed alleging non-compliance of order dated 29.11.2021Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No.20011 of 2021.

CWP No. 20011 of 2021 was disposed of vide order dated 29.11.2021. The termination order dated 14.09.2021 was quashed. It was directed that consequential benefits, if any found due, be released to the petitioner in accordance with law.

In compliance with the aforesaid order, vide office order dated 20.12.2021 the petitioner has been permitted to join duty. The only subsisting grievance of the petitioner is regarding the grant of consequential benefits.

Learned counsel for the respondent states that the case of the petitioner for grant of consequential benefits would be considered and if found entitled the amount would be released within two months.

Disposed of accordingly.
