[1] At the outset, learned counsel contends that the petitioner, who is due to retire on 31.12.2021 has served legal notice Annexure P/15 dated 02.03.2021, on the respondents, in respect of the grievance which is the subject matter of the instant petition but no decision has been taken in respect thereto till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide legal notice Annexure P/15 dated 02.03.2021, in accordance with law, in a timebound manner.

[3] Mr. R.K.S. Brar, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and on perusal of the writ petition states that the claim of the petitioner is highly belated but he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.
